Kia Ora and welcome to our 2014 AGM. It is my pleasure to present this, my 13th Report on both our newsletter and website.

T**E REO** – The structure of the newsletter in both electronic and hardcopy format continues to remain constant throughout the year and I am always so extremely grateful to those members whom contribute material for publication, thank you all.

As always, the Black & White hardcopy issues of *Te Reo* are an important and permanent record of the group's activities although the newsletter is best viewed in full colour online through the groups' website.

Hardcopy details of the newsletter (August 2013 to May 2014) are as follows;

- **Aug 2013 41 Hardcopies/24pages A\$101.26**
- **Nov 2013 41 Hardcopies/24pages A\$101.26**
- **Feb 2014 41 Hardcopies/24pages A\$116.40 (Incl. AGM Insert)**
- **May 2014 41 Hardcopies/24pages A\$101.26**

This represents 164 hardcopies with a total printing cost of A\$420 or approximately A\$2.57 per issue –very slight but still an increase on last year's printing costs.

Printing receipts have been deposited with the Secretary for inspection. *N.B. The Covers and AGM Inserts on Green reflex are slightly more expensive than the inside B&W pages.*

W**EBSITE** – Again the website format has remained constant but functional throughout the year and has required minimal maintenance by way of occasional updates with feature articles, news items and online *Te Reo*. 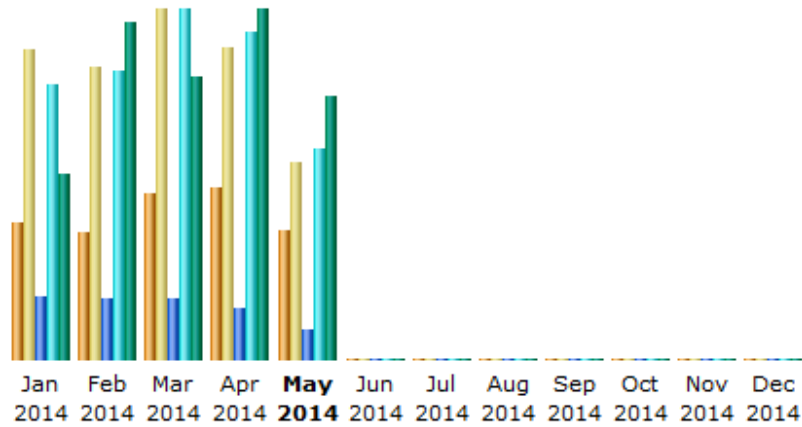


